Treasurer's Report

MOCAAPI continues to be financially strong. Dr. Gupta presented a summary of the accounts during the last MOCAAPI meeting on December 17th at the Mansion on the Plaza in Brick.

Patron Funds

This comprises of the Life Membership dues paid by all members to date. This has grown to \$ 48,400 with a total of 104 Life members.

Charitable Funds

The two Golf outings in 2009 and 2010 added a net of \$ 27,424 to our charitable account. A modest \$ 1,625 was spent on the health fairs and \$ 1,500 was used in donations.

Operating Funds

Gala 2009 and 2010 added a net of \$ 45,849 to our operating account. Out of this a total of \$ 22,000 was donated to FoodBank. The two picnics made a modest loss of \$ 1,002. The website redesign costs were partially offset by the web ads. All in all we added \$ 24,276 to the operating account.

Scholarships for High School Students

MOCAAPI has partnered with Community Medical Center and the Medical Staff of CMC to give away six scholarships of \$ 2,000 each to High school students from Toms River in the year 2011. The details and criteria are being worked out.

Membership Update

37 New Members

We added a total of 37 new Life Members to MOCAAPI during the years 2009 and 2010 taking our total count to 104. This represents about 25-30% of all estimated American-Indian Physicians in Monmouth & Ocean Counties. This is much better than any other physician organization. Thank you all.
